Metallic Waste Treatment Service

The Metallic Waste Treatment Service was introduced in the Waste Services Contract on 1st April 2010 and a number of Customers have now utilised this service to reduce waste disposal volumes. Under the new Framework Agreements, LLW Repository Ltd is now able to offer the following Service Providers and facilities for the treatment of Metallic Waste:

Combustible Waste Treatment Service

The Combustible Waste Treatment Service will be introduced in October 2010 as part of the proposed amendment to the Waste Services Contract, as detailed in the Contract Amendment section below. Under the new Framework Agreements, LLW Repository Ltd will be able to offer the following Service Providers and facilities for the treatment of Combustible Waste:

Contract Amendment

To support the introduction of the new treatment facilities, LLW Repository Ltd is developing an amendment to the Waste Services Contract that will include changes to the relevant Documents,

Processes, Guides, Forms and Templates to include the Combustible Waste Treatment Service as a new waste service option. We are also taking this opportunity to make a number of improvements and resolve issues that have been identified during the first six months of utilising the Waste Acceptance Procedure. The Contract Amendment will address all technical and commercial matters associated with utilising the new treatment facilities.

We are developing draft documents now and we will publish these on our website in September for comment. We will issue a further Customer Notice to explain the changes we intend to make with the draft proposals.

Environmental Permit Variation

LLW Repository Ltd is also working with the Environment Agency to seek a variation to the Environmental Permit to support access to the new treatment facilities. We will provide further details on this process in our Contract Amendment proposals.
