Thank you for taking the time to attend this public consultation on the proposals for the future development and closure of the Low Level Waste Repository (LLWR). The LLWR has been a key fixture of the Cumbrian Coast for many decades. Originally the site served a vital national role as the Royal Ordnance Factory from 1939 and today it continues that vital national role as the primary repository for UK low level radioactive waste.

Its future role is set by the UK Low Level Waste (LLW) Strategy which requires its optimised use to provide ongoing disposal capacity for LLW. In response, we are seeking to provide this capacity to ensure that the Repository continues to meet the long-term needs of the UK and the subsequent site closure.

We recognise the need to be a good neighbour and work closely with the surrounding communities to ensure that the proposals are understood and feedback can be received and considered.
